

Knights Landing Stable Rules



- Horses are not to be ridden on the property without someone else being present.
- ALL riders must sign a Hold Harmless release form.
- All riders must wear protective head gear and paddock or field boots when riding.
- No one under the age of 18 is allowed to be riding or caring for any horse without an adult present.
- Horses are not to be left unattended on the crossties.
- If you use something, put it back.
- If you borrow something, ask first.
- Please clean up after your horse ASAP, this includes but is not limited to: Manure in aisle way, ring, wash stall or grassy area, dirt/hair on aisle floor from grooming/clipping/cleaning feet.
- Do not feed grain to your horse without permission. Horses are kept on a group schedule and we want to prevent double feeding.
- Tack should be clean and hung in proper order in tack room.
- Stable supplies, ie: Bedding/Hay is to be distributed by barn employees unless specific permission is given.
- If a lesson is being taught in the ring, please give the lesson the right of way.
- NO jumping higher than 2ft w/out Trainer approval. Farm horses need daily approval.
- Do not move jumps in the ring without permission, lines are measured.
- 24 hr advance notice of cancelling a scheduled lessons is expected unless emergency. Full payment will be expected if proper notice is not given.
- During wet conditions, please be considerate when riding in grassy areas.
- No riding through yard around house – follow fence line or path to track/walking trail.
- Kubota is to be used as a “work” horse. Permission must be given for authorized use.
